As June Tenor of all the White Lands  
Wilmington, Vermont. & other Rights belonging  
to the Society & Parish Church of St. James  
in the County of Benning & now in the possession  
of Mr. John Peasey Pastor thereof on his  
Departure. The 14th Day of June in the year of our  
Lord 1780.

Surprised the Site of the Rectory. The Parsonage  
House three Barns with three Stables two gardens  
& an Out-house & a Cow & Horse.

Item Two hundred & sixty five Aers of Land, (a  
mile or more in the Topography of Water & now in  
possession of Robert Gorton.

Item There is also within the said Parish a Little  
Hammer belonging to the Rectory, to which several  
Cops hold Grants & are that of Justice

Item The said Rectory is parcel of the Church of  
the Village & is now in the possession of the  
Pastor & is now in the possession of the  
in the Parish of St. James & is now in the  
possession of the said R. Peasey on the 14th
